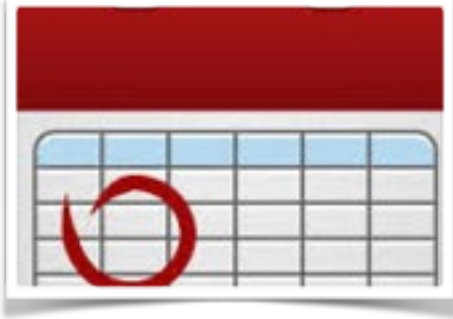


Caroling/Early Release
