Thursday Not available due to staff meeting

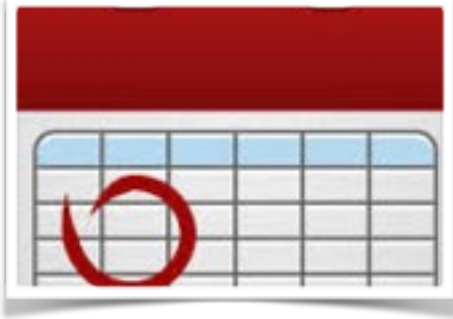
Friday By appointment only
