

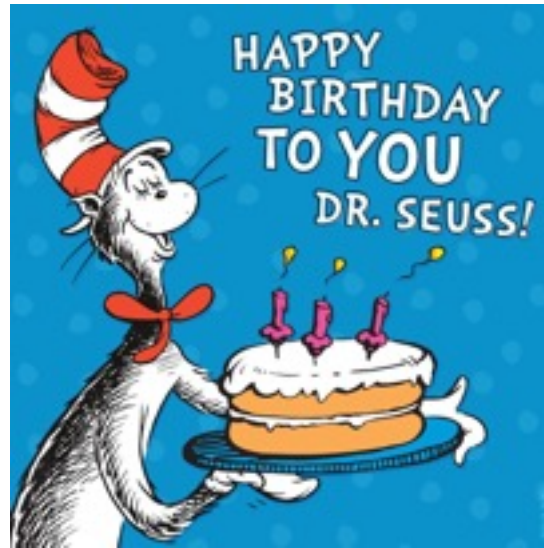
# THIS WEEK'S NEWS

## Dress Code

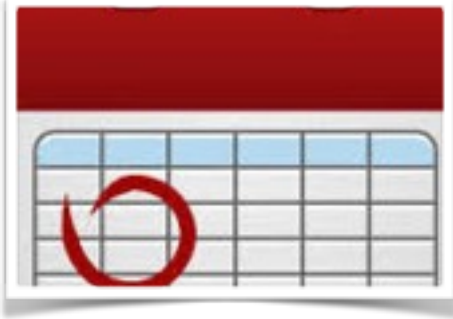
