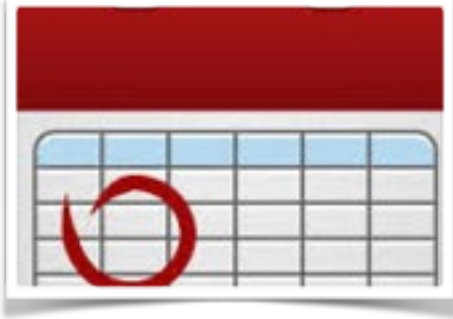
My understanding is that following this Chapsembly, we will be waiting until January for our next Chapsembly.
