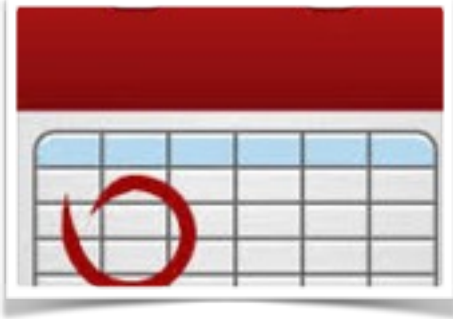


Canyonview

Safety at Drop Off/Pick Up

The teachers and staff at SCS want your child to be safe. For that reason, we request that students do not arrive to school prior to 7:45. We are not able to supervise students outside these hours, and it is not safe for students to be wandering around campus without supervision. Please help us with this safety concern by staying with your child until a teacher arrives at the gym at 7:45 or waiting to drop your child off until after 7:45.

We also request that students be picked up by 3:15. Teachers are able to supervise their own students until 3:15, but when a student is still here after 3:15, we have them wait at the office. There is not much space outside the office, so if there are several students waiting it can become noisy and distracting. Out of respect for our wonderful secretaries, we ask that you pick your child up prior to 3:15. We understand that situations will arise that allow exceptions; however, please do your best not to make the exceptions become routine. It really does create a distracting work space for our secretaries and take their focus off of their duties to supervise students.
