
# **Oregon Coast Aquarium FT**

# Morning Work

Several parents have asked me questions about the Morning Work pages that have come home with your child's other work. Some of the questions I have gotten are:

#### "Does he/she need to finish it and turn it in?"

#### "Why is it not completed?"

**The answers are:** No, your child does not need to complete it and turn it in. I ask that they use the morning work time wisely in class, but do not require that they finish it. It serves as a warmup, and each child "warms up" at a different rate.

#### What do I expect each student to complete?

I ask that they write their name, the date <u>or</u> the day of the week (1st grade has day of the week, 2nd grade has date), and ONE other question. If they are able to answer more, then that's what I ask of them. Currently, many students are barely able to get their name, date or day of the week, and one other question completed on the page. I don't want to overwhelm them.

One other factor that plays into how much they are able to complete is the amount of time we have for morning work. I try to get to calendar time by 8:35 so we can start Math as close to 8:45 as possible, which means if we arrive to the classroom from the gym later one day than another, we will have less morning work time.
