Pie Orders!

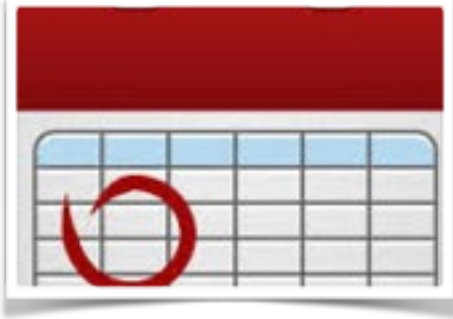
Pie orders are **due tomorrow, September 30!**

Progress Reports and Returned Work
