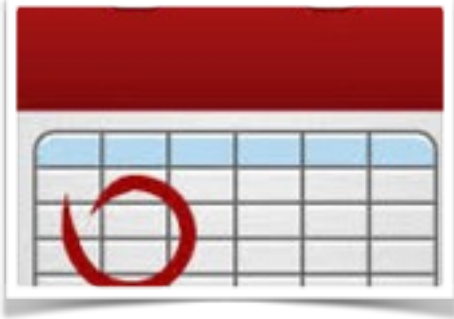

Parent Volunteers

I love to have parents come and volunteer in my classroom. I believe that a student is most successful when the teacher and the family partner together. There are several times throughout the week when help is most appreciated, but if you'd like to come volunteer other times, you are welcome to do so. If I don't have a specific need for a volunteer, a couple extra hands are always helpful and parents can be an extra resource for students during work time.

I do ask that you connect with in advance of volunteering. I like to provide tasks for volunteers when they come in to help, and I can only have those ready upon your arrival if I know ahead of time. Some tasks I can regularly use help with are sorting/organizing papers, copying (provided you have been trained on the copy machine-per employee handbook), and similar tasks. I also can use help during Math and Reading/Writing instruction, as I have multiple groups during these times. Math is daily from 8:45-9:45am, and Reading/Writing is daily from 10:10-11:40am (with the exception of a break in the middle on Wednesdays for Chapel from 10:30-11:00am).
